

## BUYING GUIDE



Group your guests into three groups. 1 Big drinkers, 2 Moderate drinkers and 3 Light drinkers and estimate how many drinks each of those groups will have and then add them together.

Once you have the number of drinks needed then you need to work out how much alcohol and mixers to buy.

Research your cocktail recipes and write down the ingredients and method for each. Most cocktails require 30ML (one shot) or 60ML (two shots). You will then need to divide the number of ML in a bottle by 30ML eg; 750ml bottle divided by 30ml = 25 shots. If your cocktail requires one shot each then that equals 25 cocktails per bottle. If your cocktails requires 2 shots then that is 12.5 cocktails per bottle. Adjust calculations for the size of your bottle eg; If your bottle is 1L then divide 1000 by 30 and so forth.

Repeat this step for all mixers.

For garnishes please supply enough for each drink.
